

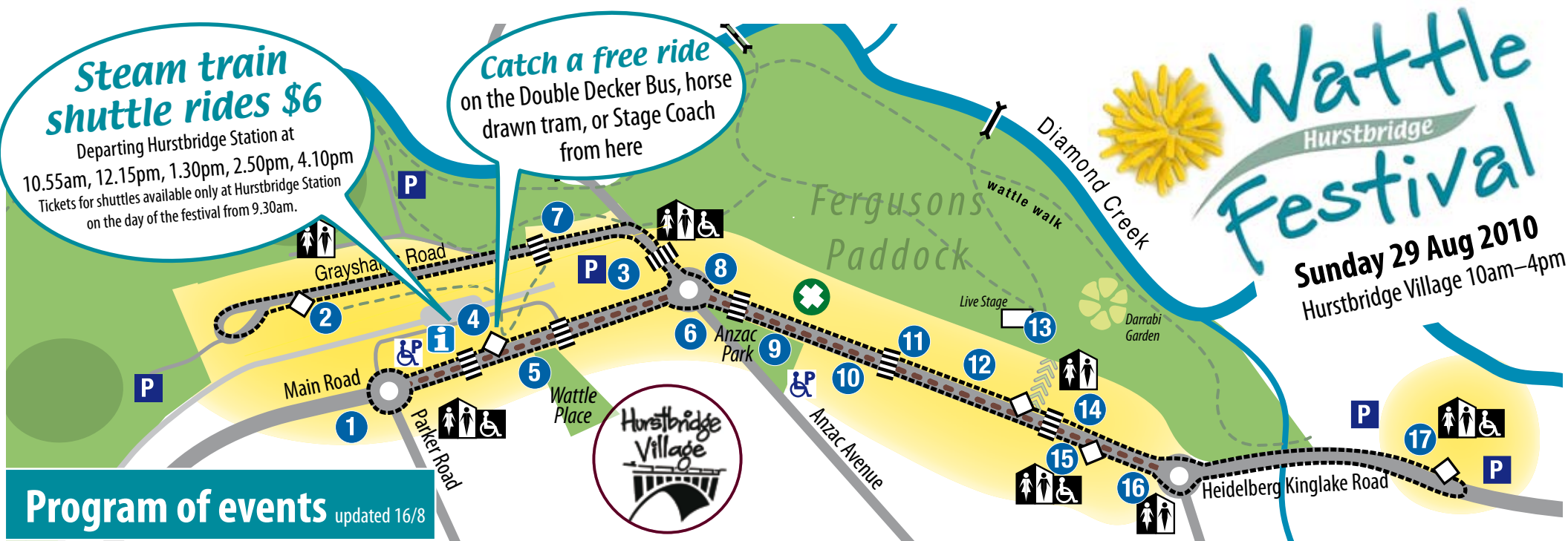
## Steam train shuttle rides \$6
